**Report on the use of the Promotion of Reading Grant (2020/21)**

**Part 1: Evaluation of the Effectiveness**

1. The major objectives for Promotion of Reading are:

- 1) Motivate students to read through various activities
- 2) Cultivate students' interest in reading and build up their reading habit
- 3) Encourage students to read to broaden their horizons

2. Evaluation of the strategies used:

**1) Motivate students to read through various activities**

Various activities such as the Owl Programme, drama plays, book sharing by teachers or students were held by the Library to motivate students to read. Students were engaged in the activities and learnt the importance of reading books.

**2) Cultivate students' interest in reading and build up their reading habit**

Every Tuesday and Thursday's morning, there were Reading periods. Students were required to read books quietly. After the reading time, there were sharing by the writers through video to cultivate students' reading interests.

**3) Encourage students to read to broaden their horizons**

A wide range of books were provided in the Library, including academic books. In order to help students broaden their horizons, the Library renewed and bought some new books about different cultures and languages like Japanese, Korean, French novels from different countries and some non-local magazines.

Apart from holding events to cultivate students' interest in reading, the Library also provided information to encourage students to participate in various reading events, like Best Ten Books Election and 423 World Reading Day. Through the activities, students could expand their knowledge through reading.
